



The DOLE BEEP Adjustment Measures Program (AMP) offers a comprehensive package of assistance for formal sector workers affected by the temporary closure of the Boracay Island. It aims to enhance their employability and competitiveness, as well as mitigate the adverse economic impact of the island's rehabilitation.

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

Financial Support

Financial relief equivalent to 50% of the prevailing minimum wage in the region for displaced and suspended workers, and 25% for retained workers who do not receive regular wage

Employment Facilitation

Access to available job opportunities suitable to the beneficiary's qualifications

Training

Trainings fit to the needs of the beneficiary for skills enhancement and employability

2-STEP APPLICATION PROCESS

1

Submit complete requirements to the BEEP Operations Center – DOLE Satellite Desk, DOLE Regional Office VI or one of its Field of Offices; or to the nearest DOLE Regional/Field/Satellite Offices for workers who have gone back to their hometown.

2

DOLE RO VI shall evaluate the application within 3 working days upon receipt, after which the applicant may expect either a Notice of Approval or Denial through registered mail or electronic mail.

Note: Applications submitted to DOLE Offices other than DOLE RO VI will take an additional two working days for endorsement and processing.

HOW MUCH IS THE FINANCIAL SUPPORT FROM BEEP AMP?

For displaced and suspended workers, 50% of the prevailing minimum wage in Region VI or Php 4,205.50 per month, deposited monthly to the beneficiary's Land Bank of the Philippines account for a maximum period of 6 months.

For retained workers who do not receive regular wage, 25% of the prevailing minimum wage in the region (Php 2,102.75) covering a 3-month period, deposited in lump sum to the beneficiary's Land Bank of the Philippines account.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CONTINUED RELEASE OF THE FINANCIAL SUPPORT?

Beneficiaries approved to receive the full six-month FS coverage are required to submit, on or before the 15th day of each month:

- a. a Beneficiary Progress Report;
- b. two (2) proof of active search for employment or job contact; and
- c. one (1) proof of attendance to any training conducted by a government agency (for the first and fourth months of availment only).
