

PROVISION OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO BENEFICIARIES

A total of 1,553 were reported displaced from 108 HEIs nationwide and 904 (58%) program beneficiaries were provided assistance since the implementation of the program in June 2016. Of the 904 beneficiaries:

- 487 or 54% were women while 417 or 46% were men;
- 731 or 81% were teaching personnel while 173 or 19% were non-teaching;
- highest availment is from the age bracket of 41-50 years old;
- National Capital Region has the highest number of displacement and availment; and
- 314 or 35% completed the program by the end of 2017, either receiving the full financial support amount for their approved coverage duration or were incentivized by finding subsequent full-time wage employment prior the end of their approved coverage.

REPORTED DISPLACEMENT

Overall, 1,553 displaced HEI personnel were reported. Highest displacement for 2018 was recorded in July (25 or 31%).

PROGRAM AVAILMENT

Overall, there are **904 beneficiaries** – 298 (33%) of which were provided assistance in 2018. Other displaced personnel were verified to be currently employed in other institutions/companies, availed of government scholarships, were rehired in their same institution, or were no longer reachable. A total of 23 (3%) beneficiaries were also referred to TESDA for skills training while 39 (4%) were referred to the DOLE Kabuhayan for livelihood assistance.
